

Policy Statement: The Council of the Village of Innisfree will provide direction to standardize the priority and procedure for snowplowing of Village roadways.

General:

1. The Village will commence snow removal on municipal roads if there is:
 - a) Three inches of snow accumulation on Village roads. The Village foreman may commence snow removal upon approval of the C.A.O. on weekends or non regular hours.
2. Priority for plowing roads with a heavy snowfall shall be as follows:
 - a) Fire Hall
 - b) School bus drop off and pick up area
 - c) Main streets
 - d) Residential and back alleys, starting with the two major south side streets that are on the hill (51st and 52nd Street)
 - e) The Landfill/Waste Transfer Station access road
 - f) Back alleys only become a priority when the snowfall does not allow emergency vehicle access or garbage vehicle access
 - g) Snow removal on driveways is the responsibility of residents/ratepayers unless a liability waiver has been signed and a request for clearance submitted to the Village Office. The removal of snow from driveways will not be considered a priority.
3. Within 72 hours of a major snowfall the Public Works Department will have all roads accessible with major cleaning to be done as time and conditions allow.
4. The procedure for snow removal and ice control shall be as follows:
 - a) Removal of as much snow or ice as possible shall be done with suitable plowing equipment;
 - b) Treatment of remaining snow or ice with sand, salt or sand/salt combination shall be done to achieve good winter driving conditions;
 - c) Plowing and de-icing activities shall continue as weather and operational conditions permit.
5. When good winter driving conditions have been achieved along all routes, cleanup activities will commence (plowing of shoulders and removal of windrows).
6. Attached Village map will color code priority areas for snowplowing plan.
