

# Community Garden 2023 Handbook



# **PROCESS:**

- 1. Contact the Village of Innisfree to obtain an application via:
  - www.innisfree.ca or admin@innisfree.ca or
  - 780-592-3886
- 2. Review the guidelines and application requirements.
- 3. Complete the application and submit.
- 4. Once your application has been reviewed and if accepted, you will be notified of your plot location. You will have use of the plot for one growing season.

# **AGREEMENT:**

The Innisfree Community Garden project is made possible with the support of the following partner:

 Village of Innisfree – provision of vacant lot, preparation of garden space, grass maintenance and water supply

The Village of Innisfree agrees to:

- 1. Market the project and communicate with residents
- 2. Prepare the soil for initial planting
- 3. Ensure grass borders are maintained
- 4. Provide access to fresh water (water tank to be filled once/week)
- 5. Cancel this agreement if the Gardener does not adhere to the guidelines attached

# **GUIDELINES:**

### **PLANTING**

- Garden plots are reserved on a first come first served basis
- Past gardeners will have first offer to the garden plot they had in the previous year. They
  will be required to sign an agreement when offered the plot.
- Garden plots will be assigned by the Village of Innisfree.
- Garden plots may be planted on or after Friday, May 19, 2023
- Garden plots must be completely vacated by Sunday, October 15, 2023

### WATER

- Water will be provided by the Village of Innisfree.
- Tank will be filled once/week.
- Gardeners are to provide their own watering cans or buckets.

### **TOOLS**

- Storage for tools is not provided on site.
- Gardeners must bring their own tools (hoes, shovels, gloves, planting stakes, etc.)

### **WEED & PEST CONTROL**

Use of pesticides, herbicides, DDT derivatives or animal poisons is strictly PROHIBITED.

# **TRASH & RECYCLING**

Gardeners are to haul out all trash, recycling and compost.

# **PETS**

- Only service animals can be permitted on site: animals must be leashed, wearing service vest/identification and not in direct contact with edibles.
- It is recommended to wash hands before and after interacting with pets.

#### PREPARATION AND PLANTING OF GARDEN PLOT

- Gardeners can plan annual produce, plants or flowers only.
- No invasive plants are allowed. Visit <a href="https://www.alberta.ca/about-invasive-plants-and-weeds.aspx">https://www.alberta.ca/about-invasive-plants-and-weeds.aspx</a> for more information.
- No bushes, hedges, trees or other perennial plants are permitted.
- No fences or structures may be erected, such as benches, picnic tables and arbors.
- Plant supporting structures may be used, such as tomato cages and frost coverings.
- No illegal substances may be consumed or planted in the community garden.

### MAINTENANCE OF GARDEN PLOT

- Weeds must be maintained on a weekly basis.
- Gardeners must arrange for someone to tend to the plot if away for an extended period.
- Gardeners are asked to haul out all trash, recycling and litter.

# **SAFETY & SECURITY**

- Always supervise children and pets.
- Harvest only from your garden plot.
- Acquaint yourself with your garden neighbors.
- Report any theft or vandalism to the Village of Innisfree.
- No smoking is permitted in any part of the community garden.

# **PHOTOS**

- The community garden is a public place and photos are permitted to be taken.
- The Village of Innisfree may also take photos and use them for marketing purposes.

# **TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP**

### **GARDENERS:**

- Gardeners may terminate their membership at any time by notifying the Village of Innisfree.
- Gardeners are responsible for returning their plot to its original state upon termination.

# Village of Innisfree:

- The Village may terminate membership if the Gardener is not complying with the guidelines.
- The Village will contact the Gardener and the Gardener will be given seven days to tend to their plot.
- If, after seven days, the Gardener does not comply, the plot will be tilled under.

# **Application Form**
