August and September 2023 Campground update

- Removed all garbage bins due to rotting and decaying wood and attracting bears; have had significant bear activity this year.
- Replaced the garbage bins with one bear-proof garbage bin with a metal lid, placed in the parking lot across from the Campground Registration office. This was to eliminate all the broken trash that campers leave after camping; signs on silver bins state: NO BROKEN CAMPING ITEMS OR BOXES ALLOWED.
- The only remaining garbage cans are the silver ones with lids; they must be emptied frequently.
- The big, long green (cardboard) bin should be removed from the campground as campers are driving up to the back of the Registration Office/shop to dump garbage; Added a chain and posts across that access, to eliminate people driving into that area.
- The Toro Tractor mower was sold.
- Received the new John Deere mower; it works fantastic and covers a lot more area.

Closure of Campground Processes:

- The bathroom and boiler room issues have been fixed.
- Replaced toilet handles, a tap, and a leaking pipe in the group building.
- The baseball diamond doors have been replaced with plywood and doorhandles. (Will stain doors before the end of the season and add a hook to the inside for closure.)
- Lights were put in across all washrooms; some of those may need to be replaced, as the string does not work.
- Main outhouse doors have been fixed; all screws and nails have been removed that were visible, and doorhandles were added.
- All buildings have been cleaned and locked up; all electrical panels are shut off.
- Registration Office and shop will be closed and boarded up this coming week.
- Due to my recent accident, (with a deer incident on Sunday, September 17th) I will not be able to complete any more mowing this season; all remaining machinery have been moved back to the PW Shop.
- Currently there is one site booked until end of September, and one site that is week by week, pending completion of the individual's job.
- Campground will be seasonally closed on Sept 30th.
